Concept Note

Background

Objectives of the meeting

The overall objective of the meeting is to share ideas on the way forward for RUFORUM in the next decade. The specific objectives of the meeting relate to how best RUFORUM can position itself to mobilise resources for its sustainability from the sectors represented by the small group at the meeting.
